The Inauguration of the Kingdom of God

The geographical references in today's readings from Isaiah and Matthew are highly significant. The lands of Zebulun and Naphtali were the territories of the northern-most tribes of Israel. In 721 BC, the Assyrians invaded these regions and destroyed the Northern Kingdom of Israel. Later, in 587 BC, the Babylonians destroyed the Southern Kingdom of Judah, sending the population into exile. Matthew uses these geographical allusions deliberately to teach that Jesus' public ministry inaugurates the restoration of God's kingdom where it was first extinguished. Jesus brings God's light and salvation into these areas of desolation, fulfilling the prophet Isiah's hope: "The people who walked in darkness/have seen a great light; upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom / a light has shone" (Is 9:1).

Jesus enters Galilee with the challenge: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Mt 4:17). Unambiguously, Jesus proclaims his intention to inaugurate God's kingdom. He issues a call to enter a new relationship with God by undergoing a change of heart.

Jesus invites two sets of brothers, Peter and Andrew and James and John, to follow him. His call comes amid their daily occupations. They respond promptly by abandoning their ordinary activities and redirecting their lives to a new way of service to the Lord and the establishment of his kingdom.

Jesus' call comes to each of us in our everyday activities. In baptism, we are called to recognise that "the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Mt 3:2). In our daily lives, we experience Jesus' presence and witness that we are his followers.
