## Parables of Hope


In today's Gospel reading, we hear Jesus using parables to teach his disciples and the crowds about the Kingdom of God. For Jesus, the reality of the Kingdom of God was best explained by drawing on images and experiences from the daily life of the Galilean villagers.

As we hear in the First Reading today from the prophet Ezekiel, Jewish tradition sometimes compared God's work in the world to the growth of plants and trees. Ezekiel, a prophet in the early stages of Israel's exile in Babylon, prophesied that one day God would restore the exiled Israelites to a mighty and powerful nation, as in the days of King David, when Israel stood as "a majestic cedar". It was a message of hope for a broken and disheartened people.

We find a similar message of hope, with accompanying images of palm and cedar trees, in today's Responsorial Psalm. The psalmist offers a prayer of thanksgiving for God for his fidelity to those who are just and have remained faithful.

With such rich images and traditions embedded in Israel's prophetic writings and psalm prayers, it is understandable that Jesus would draw on similar agricultural metaphors, such as seeds and mustard plants, to teach the crowds and his disciples about the Kingdom of God. In his public ministry, Jesus was planting the seeds for the Kingdom of God that promised fulfilment in the future.

As Paul assures the Corinthians, we can be "courageous" in our faith in Christ. And the Kingdom of God continues to grow in our day in ways beyond human understanding.

### <u>A message from Fr Dominic</u>

"In addition to those being Ordained Priest and Deacon for the Diocese this summer, there are two who are being Ordained for Orders/Movements. Please would you keep them in prayer, and ask parishioners to pray for them.

Rev Callum Young will be Ordained a priest for the Neo-Catechumenate at St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh, on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2021. Callum is from St Michael's, East Ham. Callum travelled with the BCYS to Lourdes and World Youth Day.

Rev Joseph (Shaun) Bailham, OP will be Ordained a priest for the Dominicans at St Dominic's Church (Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary), London, on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2021. Joseph (Shaun) was part of the Team at Walsingham House in 2007/8 and served as a BCYS leader in Lourdes for several years, as well as travelling to World Youth Day in Sydney and in Madrid.
