

## TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME SUNDAY 14<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2022

Today's readings show us the suffering that God's chosen must often endure to bring people closer to God. The prophet Jeremiah is cast into a pit. The author of the second reading urges us to keep "our eyes fixed on Jesus" so that we do not "lose heart" (Heb 12:2, 3), and Jesus himself warns of the hornet's nest that his mission will stir up.

The sharp language and dramatic imagery in today's Gospel reading have been borrowed by Luke from Jewish prophetic and apocalyptic writing to express the cataclysmic significance of Jesus' teachings. His message is so radical that it will have dramatic effects – as if the earth had been set on fire. It will invite conversion in some and provoke violent resistance in others, even bringing divisions within families. If the most elemental human relationships are thrown into chaos, these words suggest, then towns and empires will be just as fractured and the natural order of the world could soon fall apart as well.

Since Jesus has already been baptized by John, the "baptism" he speaks of here cannot be read literally. It is a metaphor that anticipates his crucifixion. In fact, in the Gospel according to Luke, the long section of chapters 9-22, beginning and ending with Jesus' predictions of his sacrificial death, stands in the shadow of the cross.

The portrait of Jesus seen here is hardly the calm shepherd with a lamb on his shoulder. But is serves to draw our attention to the implications of taking Christ's message out into the world. Luke is a deliberate writer and so Jesus' words must be important to Luke's understanding of Christ and his ministry and of the stakes of discipleship demands. The anger, rejection and suffering that Jesus experienced, his disciples must be prepared for as well.
