

TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME SUNDAY 16[™] OCTOBER 2022

The Gospel contains the well-known parable of the widow and the corrupt judge. It stands in the midst of Jesus' teaching on prayer in the Gospel according to Luke. One of the main points of the parable, namely, that persistence is necessary in prayer, remains timeless. The cultural and temporal divides between ancient Palestine and our own time, however, leave some aspects alien to us. In particular, we today probably do not recognize how dire the situation was for widows in Jesus' day. We often characterize widows (or dramatize them on television) as successful in legal battles, even in winning against a corrupt home repairman. In ancient Palestine, however, widows were often mistreated. Women could easily be exploited and required males to speak for them in court proceedings. A widow without a son had little representation. A wealthy person who wished to swindle her out of her late husband's estate could do so with a well-placed bribe.

Jesus' audiences recognized that the deck was staked strongly against the widow. So when Jesus pictured this widow approaching a corrupt judge, his point was not about ordinary persistence but resolute perseverance in the face of nearly insurmountable odds. In the end, this is a definitive portrait of faith. Believing despite the fact that your first attempt failed, and your second and your third, shows faith's true character. Faith is not really about winning; it is about carrying on in the face of failure.

And that is what prayer appears to be for Jesus in Luke's account of the Gospel. It is not merely about getting what we want but about believing that possibilities lie beyond the difficult reality set before us. It is about believing that God can bring good out of any daunting reality.
