EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD SUNDAY 17th APRIL 2022

Raised with Christ

The Scriptures for this Easter Sunday focus on the earliest witness to the resurrection, calling Christians today to continue the mission of bearing witness to Christ and the Gospel. In the legal system of ancient Judaism, witnesses gave testimony based on first-hand experience. In serious matters, more than one witness was required for acceptable testimony.

In the Old Testament, the Lord called the covenant people to bear witness to YHWH before all other nations, who worshiped numerous false gods. When God delivered the chosen people from their exile in Babylon, Isaiah proclaimed God's word to them: "You are my witnesses" (Is 40:10, 12). Israel of old was specifically designated to give testimony to God as "saviour" and "redeemer" (Is 40:11, 14).

Today's first reading presents disciples who have experienced the resurrection, God's final act to save and give life. Death itself is conquered: the same Jesus who was crucified, "God raised on the third day" (Acts 10:40). Those who witnessed Jesus' execution have also experienced him alive, in God's new life. They are thus "commissioned" (Acts 10:42) to testify in word and deed that God's "mercy endures forever" (Ps 118:1). Like Jesus, his followers bear witness to the now-fulfilled words of the psalmist: "I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD" (ps. 118:17).

To give testimony that Christians are "raised with Christ" (Col 3:1) requires more than words of witness. The second reading insists that those who share in his resurrection must die to their former way of life in order to give believable testimony. Genuine witness to what God has done in Jesus Christ requires daily action marked by evidence that the believer now lives "with Christ in God" (Col 3:3).

Colossians 3:1-4 also is meant as a guide for community life. Each "you" is plural. Re-read 3:1-4 from the plural perspective. What might "what is above" and "what is on earth" (3:2) mean for life in a community of faith?
