FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT SUNDAY 27th MARCH 2022

God of Mercy and Compassion

The continuing Old Testament story of God's covenant relationship with Israel reaches another stage of fulfilment in today's first reading. The Israelites complete their arduous journey through the wilderness, finally reaching the land promised centuries ago to Abraham's descendants. In celebrating Passover, they remember God's enduring faithfulness despite their own unfaithfulness. They feast on the "produce of the land" (Jos 5:11), no longer needing the heavenly manna; through God's compassion, they have passed over from slavery to freedom.

The second reading speaks of new freedom brought through Christ. In this new Passover, believers become "a new creation" (2 Cor 5:16), fully reconciled to God through Christ. St. Paul reminds us that we are called to respond to God's saving activity by becoming "ambassadors for Christ" (5:20) who continue God's reconciling work in our world.

Luke draws a detailed portrait of the height and depth of reconciling mercy. In Jesus' parable of a father and two sons, the father's unimaginable, extravagant forgiveness evokes different responses. The younger son first offends by demanding his inheritance from a still-living father. He adds insult and shame to the family when he squanders the money and is reduced to feeding unclean animals. Even his planned return springs from self-interest: he is homeless, starving.

The father displays almost mad joy in dashing out to meet his wayward son. (In Jesus' time, the head of a household did not run in public.) Further, the father showers a boy who has brought him shame and heartache with signs of favoured son-ship: fine clothing, proper footwear, a ring. In response to this extravagant mercy, the younger son admits his sin with sorrow. But the seemingly faithful son reacts with anger, jealousy and bitterness. How do you account for the difference.
