FATHER MAY THEY BE COMPLETELY ONE

In today's first reading, we see the continuity between Luke's two volumes (the Gospel and Acts of the Apostles). Because Luke wants to demonstrate the merciful Saviour's work continuing in his followers, Acts occasionally presents an event similar to one in the Gospel. In the first reading, as Stephen is executed he asks the risen Christ that he too might pass through death to new life. Like Jesus, Stephen faces death with a prayer of forgiveness for his executioners.

The author of Revelation strains toward Jesus' final coming, which will bring to completion God's reign over new heavens and a new earth. When Christ the "beginning and the end" (Rv 22:13) of all things appears in full glory, believers will enjoy the plentiful, life-giving water promised by Isaiah (55:1) in his vision of God's salvation.

The Gospel text, taken from the Last Supper discourse, presents Jesus' prayer for disciples of all generations. In John's telling of the Good News, Jesus delivers this lengthy farewell speech shortly before his death, which the evangelist presents as the full revelation of God in Jesus. For John, Jesus' life is in no way taken from him; he freely chooses to lay down his life for those he loves.

Addressing his followers, Jesus emphasizes oneness in love. Because of his loving oneness with God, because he is the divine Word made flesh, Jesus reveals the mystery of God in his very self. In his death, he reveals love giving itself totally so that others may live. Disciples who unite themselves to Jesus are united to the Father through him; thus united to God, they are sent as Jesus was, and for the same mission: to reveal God as love, giving life itself for others.
