

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD (A) SUNDAY 2ND APRIL 2023

"He was humbler yet, even to accepting death, death on a cross"

The Passion story from Matthew is bleak indeed. It starts with the betrayal by Judas and then Jesus accurately predicts that all his disciples will desert him, even Peter. No angel comes to minister to Jesus in Gethsemane and give him strength, as happens in Luke's account. Jesus is spat at and "hit with fists" before the Sanhedrin. He is mocked right up to the point of death, and cries out, "My God, my God, why have you deserted me?" Note the cosmological dimension of the crucifixion – the sky turning dark, the earth quaking and rocks splitting. Those present must have been terrified.

The story grips us. It encompasses the best and worst of human nature. Can we empathise with the plight of Judas, who tries to undo a terrible mistake but finds that it is too late? Shall we blame the disciples for choosing sleep over prayer? Did the follower of Jesus who drew his sword and injured the high priests' servant act unreasonably? Apparently Jesus thought so. Being a man of peace, he ordered the man to put his sword away, "for all who draw the sword will die by the sword". Notice that it was the women following Jesus who stayed with him right up to the end, even though they were kept at a distance.

Elements of the story will resonate with all of us, for what they reflect about human nature. It was this very humanity that Jesus embraced. Jesus was betrayed by practically everybody, but he did not betray our humanity. That he could do this is the foundation of our ultimate hope, not only in God, but in humanity too.

Where do we see ourselves on Palm Sunday? Do we recognise elements of ourselves in the cheering crowd, yelling for a messiah that might free them from oppressive overlords, but then turning against him; in the disciples who ran away when Jesus was arrested; in the Roman soldiers, given the dirty job of executing criminals; in the thieves who taunted a fellow sufferer? When we wave our crosses of palms, we recognise the cross mirrored in us, the universal family of the people of God.
